KRA	All 5K students 1 X Per Year	Measures readiness for Kindergarten in 4 domains: Social Foundations, Language and Literacy, Mathematics, Physical wellbeing and Motor Development.
CogaT/IOWA	All 2 nd Grade 1x Per Year	CogAT: Aptitude test in Verbal, Quantitative, and Non-verbal problem solving. The IOWA Assessment is a norm-referenced achievement test to measure mastery of academic skills found in the elementary curriculum Use in SC to determine eligibly for Gifted and Talented.
NAEP	Target 4 th Grade 1x Per Year	NAEP is a congressionally mandated project administered by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) within the U.S. Department of Education and the Institute of Education Sciences (IES).It is given to a representative sample of students across the country and measures what U.S. students know and can do in various subjects across the nation, states, and in some urban districts. Used for Nation's Report Card.
Performance Task Assessment	Targeted students 2nd through 5th grade 1x/year	Manipulative-based assessment Provides a hand-on dimension to measure problem-solving. Administered to select students in grades 2-5 who require 1 additional dimension to qualify for Gifted & Talented.
Reading Benchmarks (Fountas & Pinnell)	All Students Grades K-5	Interim assessments to monitor student achievement in meeting SC state standards in each content areas. Tests are used to inform instruction and revise curriculum to ensure students are on track to meeting end of the year state standards.
MAP	All Students Grades K-8	MAP is a standardized, computer adaptive test that measures academic growth over time. Results are used to drive classroom instruction.
SC Ready (ELA & Math)	All Students Grades 3 rd -8 th	Statewide assessments in English Language Arts (ELA) and math to measure mastery of the SC state standards. Results are used for state summative ratings under the SC ESSA model and formatively by the school to identify curricular modifications.
SC PASS (Science)	All Students Grades 4, 6 & 8	Statewide assessment administered in grades 4,6, and 8 to measure mastery of the SC science standards. Results are used for state summative ratings under the SC ESSA model and formatively by the school to identify curricular modifications.
SC PASS (Social Studies)	All Students Grades 5 & 7	Statewide assessment administered in grades 5 and 7 to measure mastery of the SC Social Studies standards. Results are used for state summative ratings under the SC ESSA model and formatively by the school to identify curricular modifications.
EOC (End of Course Exam)	All Students Taking Algebra 1 & English 1	Statewide assessment program of end of course test for courses awarded high school units of credit in English Language Arts and mathematics.
ACCESS (Access for English Language Learners)	Targeted Students 1x Per Year	What Is the ACCESS Test ? ACCESS stands for "Assessing Comprehension and Communication in English State-to-State for English Language Learners." It's a test that's given to students from kindergarten to grade 12, to assess their progress in learning English.
